

How to use the Landscape Character map

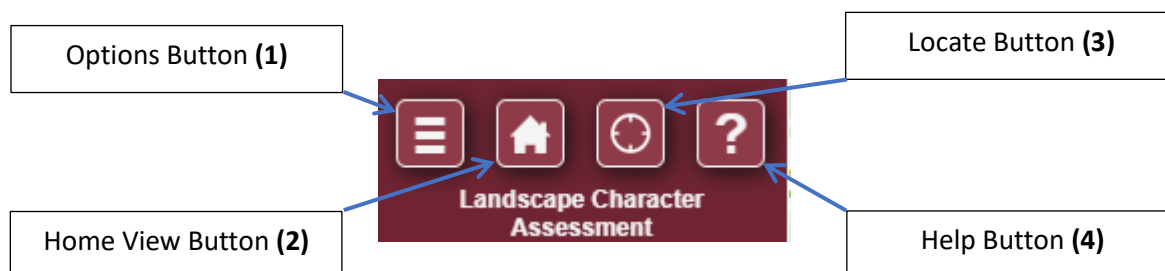
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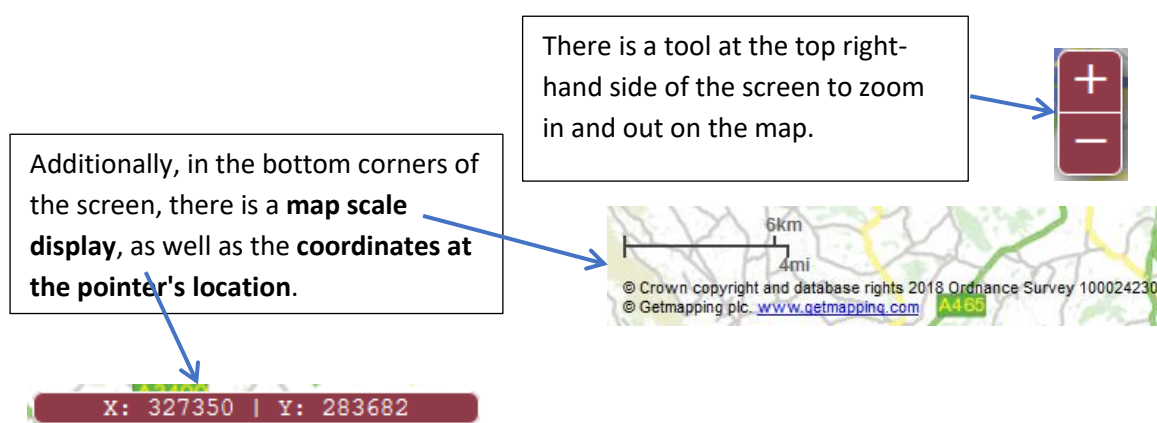


Getting Started

Upon opening the Drug and Alcohol Services map, the navigation panel will be displayed in the top left-hand corner of the screen. It looks like this:

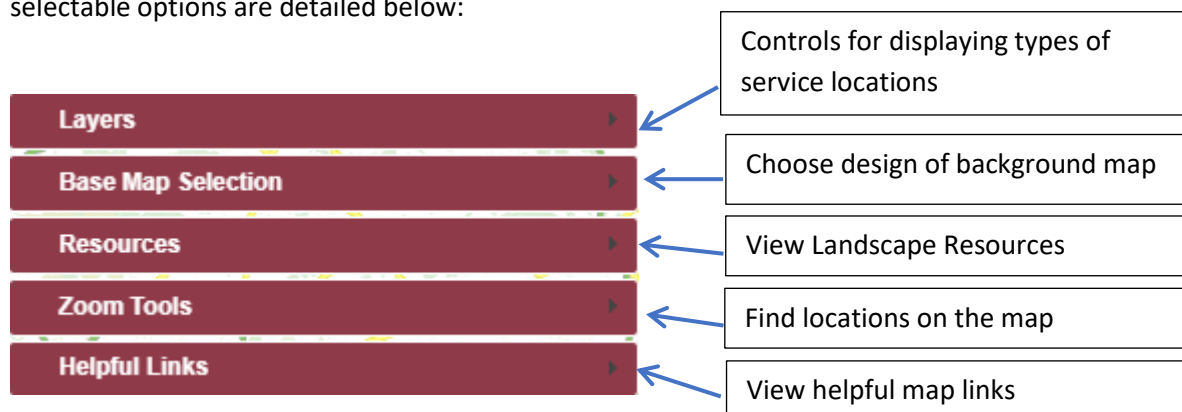


1. **Options Button:** Expands the options panel, displaying the options that can be set in the map. The options are explained in the "Options Panel" section further down this page.
2. **Home View Button:** Zooms the map out to view the full extent of Worcestershire.
3. **Locate Button:** If the location has not already been set, the locate button will get your current location and display it on the map. This information is used to find the nearest service locations.
4. **Help Button:** Displays this document.



Options Panel

The options panel gives customisation options for the Drug and Alcohol Services map. The various selectable options are detailed below:

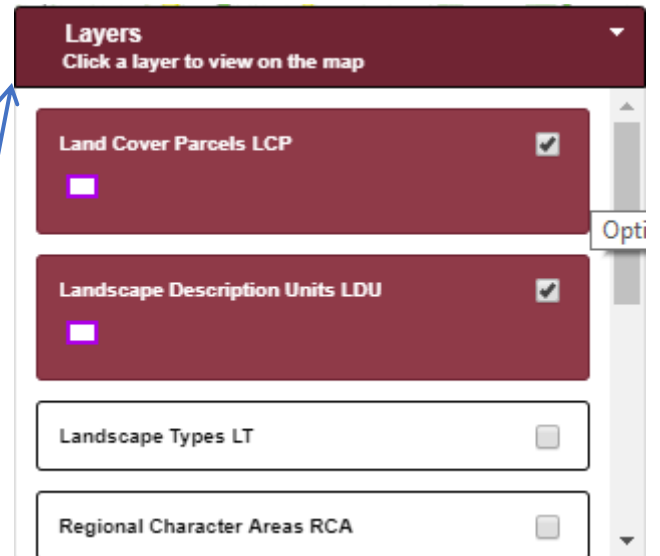


Layers

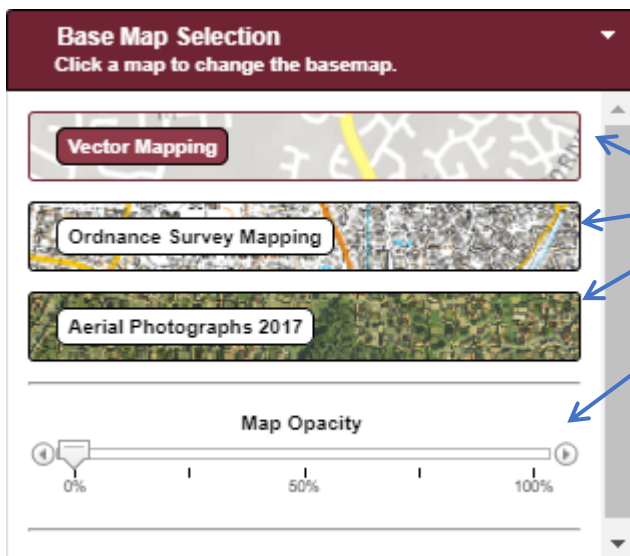
The layers panel allows different types of service locations to be displayed on the main map.

To enable or disable a layer: click on the layer box or click on the small check-box inside the layer box.

The layers panel can be minimised by clicking on the red bar at the top of the



Base Map Selection



The base map selection panel allows the background map and opacity to be changed.

To choose a new map: click the desired mapping style in the panel and it will reload the map with the new style.

To change the opacity: drag the slider and release it on the desired opacity value.


Resources

The Resources selection pane allows you to pick specific Landscape Character resources.

Just select from either of the drop downs to see the documents.



Zoom Tools




The Zoom Tools selection pane allows you to look for specific areas on the map and zoom to them.

Here you can enter a Post Code and it will zoom to that area on the map.

Enter a Grid Reference with X and Y (Eastings & Northings) and zoom to that location.

Another option is to zoom to District or Parish. You can do this by simply selecting on the desired drop-down list and picking where you want to zoom.
